No matter where you teach, what you teach, or for how long, National Board Certification can advance your practice, improve your students' learning, and energize your presence in the classroom.

Beyond gaining the title
National Board Certified
Teacher (NBCT), this process
provides the opportunity to
deeply reflect on your
practice. Created by teachers
and for teachers, National
Board Certification is tailored
to your teaching, your content,
and your specific students.



THE PROCESS

Within one to three years, you will complete four components.

- **Component 1** is a computer-based exam to assess your knowledge of your chosen content area.
- In **Component 2**, you will prepare a portfolio showing how you differentiate your teaching for students.
- Component 3, often called the video component, includes footage of you teaching along with a written analysis of your choices in those clips.
- Component 4 requires you to share how you connect your knowledge of students to your teaching decisions.

THE CORE PROPOSITIONS

Through the four components, you will demonstrate how your teaching addresses both content-areaspecific standards and the **Five Core Propositions**:

- 1. Teachers are committed to students and their learning.
- 2. Teachers know the subjects they teach and how to teach those subjects to students.
- Teachers are responsible for managing and monitoring student learning.
- 4. Teachers think systematically about their practice and learn from experience.
- 5. Teachers are members of learning communities.



Students taught by NBCTs gained the equivalent of approximately one to two months of additional instruction.
